Hello, everybody! Just a few **reminders** and **ideas** as suggested by EVEN and others:

- 1. This cruelty-free VEGAN Thanksgiving potluck is **100% vegan** and that includes <u>not</u> using honey, please. Thank you!
- 2. Please jot down the **ingredients** of your vegan dish for those who might have sensitivities. If you would please do this **in advance**, it will help the lines move more smoothly at the door. If you are bringing a commercial product, it's fine to simply cut out the <u>Ingredients Panel</u> from the package.
- 3. Remember to bring a **serving utensil** (and you might want to even tape your name to the handle!) along with your own **plates and place setting**.
- 4. You do not have to be vegan, but your dish does. Vegetarian dishes are simply not appropriate for this vegan Thanksgiving celebration. There is as much misery, suffering and pain inherent in eggs and dairy as there is in meat. Maybe moreso! So for at least this one meal on this one occasion, thank you for keeping it vegan! - 5. PLEASE, **no alcohol or smoking** permitted in the church or on church grounds. Thank you.
- 6. **Doors open at 3pm.** Only assigned EVEN volunteers helping with setup can enter before 3pm.
- 7. Beverages provided compliments of EVEN, but bring your own glass.
